In the beginning, there was nothing but God. God said, “I will create a beautiful world! So, He did and this is how it happened.

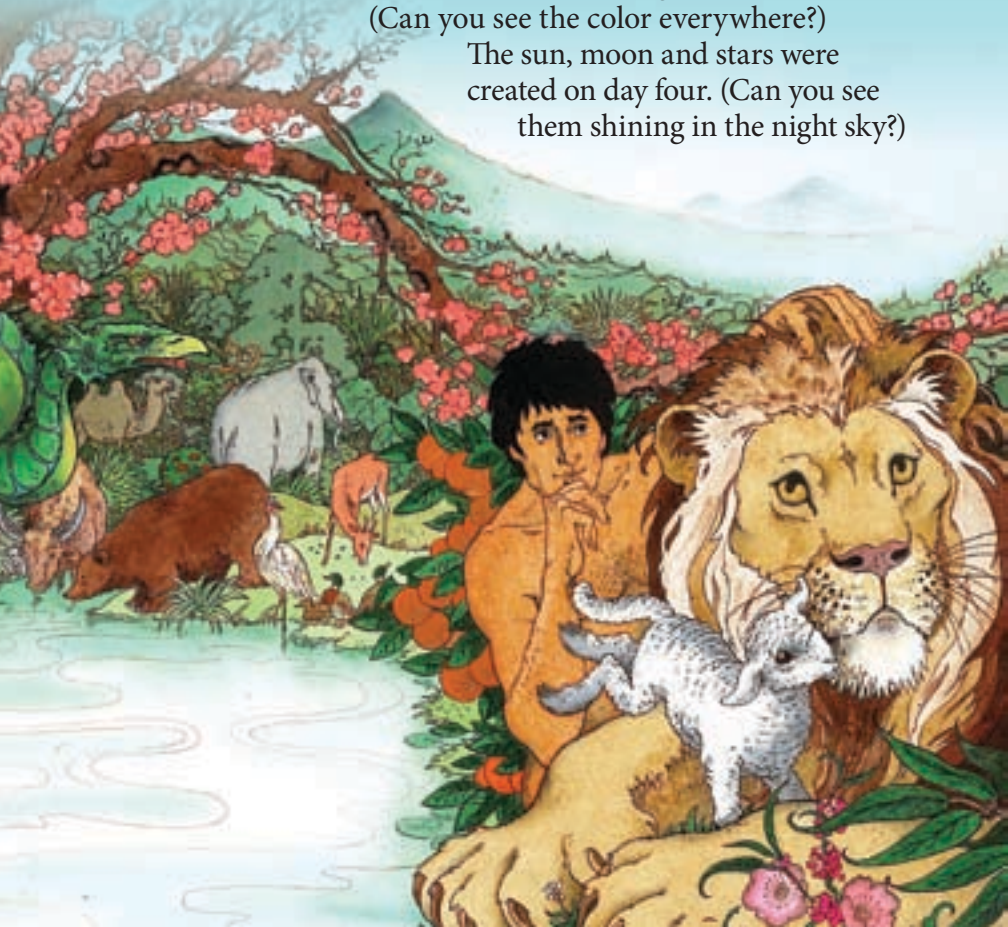
On the first day, God said, “Let there be light” and there was light! He divided light from darkness to make day and night.
